Summary

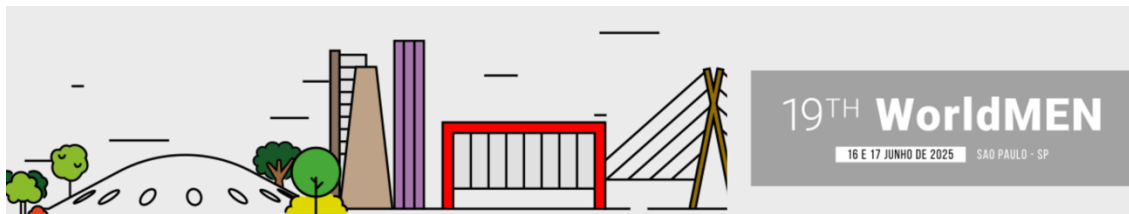
