Dear Members of the **ENEA Nomination Committee**,

On behalf of the Spanish Society of Endocrinology and Nutrition (SEEN), I am pleased to nominate Dr. Betina Biagetti MD, PhD, as candidate for the European Neuroendocrine Association (ENEA) Executive Committee for the 2026–2030 term. Dr. Biagetti is a member of ENEA in good standing and, in our view, represents an outstanding candidate whose clinical, scientific, and organisational profile is fully aligned with the aims and working mode of the Association.

Dr. Biagetti is a senior endocrinologist and Pituitary Unit Coordinator at Hospital Universitari Vall d'Hebron in Barcelona, a Spanish National Reference Center for complex hypothalamic–pituitary diseases. She has developed an extensive clinical, academic, and research career focused on neuroendocrinology, particularly in pituitary tumors, pituitary apoplexy, acromegaly, Cushing and hypothalamic disorders. Her work combines highly specialised clinical care with translational and collaborative research in complex pituitary and neuroendocrine diseases.

Within SEEN, Dr. Biagetti has demonstrated a sustained commitment to the neuroendocrine community: she served as Secretary of the Neuroendocrinology Group from 2020 to 2024 and is currently a member of the SEEN Board. She has played a major

role in the development of multicenter collaborative research initiatives in Spain and coordinates or co-coordinates several national registries. Her recent scientific activity includes collaborative work on acromegaly, pituitary apoplexy and national registry-based research, reflecting her capacity to transform clinical networks into high-quality scientific output. Throughout these activities, she has promoted close collaboration among clinicians, researchers, and reference centers, fostering effective teamwork across institutions. This experience in managing complex national networks, together with her active engagement in European Reference Network on Rare Endocrine Conditions, provides her with a solid understanding of the operational and scientific challenges involved in European-level collaboration in rare endocrine diseases.

Dr. Biagetti combines strong clinical expertise with recognized scientific productivity and experience in coordinating national collaborative networks and educational activities. Her leadership within SEEN, her role in a national reference centre, and her experience in registry-based and multicentre projects make her particularly well suited to contribute to ENEA's mission of promoting excellence in neuroendocrinology across Europe.

We believe her profile, collaborative spirit, and commitment to neuroendocrinology would represent a valuable contribution to the future development of ENEA and its international scientific community. We are confident that she would bring to the Executive Committee clinical insight, scientific rigour, organisational experience, and a genuinely collaborative European vision.

SEEN strongly supports her candidacy and would be delighted to see her contribute to the Executive Committee of the Association.
